Characteristics: What is it?

QuotationParaphraseSummaryMatches the source word for wordMatches the source in terms of meaningSums up the central point of the sourceSet off by quotation marksUses your own wordsUses your own wordsApproximately the same length, though often shorter andMuch shorter than the source

though often shorter and sometimes a little longer than the source

Purpose: Why use it?

Quotation Paraphrase Summary

To provide credibility for what you are saying (you support your point by quoting an authority) To get down the meaning of someone else's words in situations where their exact words are not important or their exact words are not appropriate or are not useful
